Bedroom:

Full mattress, box spring and frame (new)
Twin bed(s) box spring and frame (new)
Sheets and blankets
Pillows (new)
Dresser
1 lamp per room if no overhead light
(consult with JVS staff)
Alarm clock
Hangers
Laundry basket

Kitchen:

Pots and pans (at least 1 saucepan, 1 frying pan and 1 baking dish)
Rice cooker
Mixing bowls
Kitchen utensils (spatula, wooden spoon, etc)
Can opener
Cutting board
Chef Knife
Food storage set
Dish towels
Lightbulbs (new)
Large trash can and trash bags (new)

Dining:

Tableware (fork, knife, spoon)
Dishware (plates, bowls, glasses, mugs)
Kitchen/dining table and chairs

Living:

1 seat per person (couch, loveseat, easy chair, recliner)
Lamp if no overhead lighting (consult with JVS staff)
